Enactment of this bill saves the state \$91,200 General Fund and \$208,900 federal funds in FY 2013. In FY 2014 this bill saves the state \$1,193,700 General Fund and \$2,734,200 federal funds. In FY 2015 General Fund savings increase to \$1,203,500 and federal funds savings increase to \$2,756,600.
