Enactment of this bill could increase revenue to the Commerce Service Fund by \$106,100 annually. There will be a corresponding increase in expenditures to administer the provisions of the bill.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Enactment of this bill could increase licensing fees for individuals with ownership interest in unincorporated entities by \$85 dollars as a \$20 registration fee is replaced by a \$105 license fee. An estimated 1,248 individuals will be impacted.
