SHORT TITLE: Change Application Procedure

2013 GENERAL SESSION

STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will cost the Office of the Property Rights Ombudsman \$4,200 from the Commerce Service Fund and will generate \$600 revenues to the Commerce Service Fund. Commerce Service Fund spending affects the annual transfer to the General Fund. The net impact to the General Fund will be (\$3,600). The agency indicated that they can handle the additional costs within existing appropriations.
