## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

The bill could cost and generate for the Department of Health dedicated credits of \$40,000 in FY 2015, \$20,000 in FY 2016, and \$15,000 ongoing beginning in FY 2017. These costs are for:

- 1.\$\frac{1}{2}5,000 for 0.3 FTE in FY 2015 to process and issue 100 extraction cards and \$25,000 to develop a database
- 2.\$7,500 for 0.15 FTE in FY 2016 to process and issue 50 extraction cards and \$12,500 to develop a database
- 3.\$7,500 for 0.15 FTE ongoing in FY 2017 to process and issue 50 extraction cards and \$7,500 to maintain a database

Legislative General Counsel attached a Constitutional Note to this bill. If provisions in the bill are challenged in court, there will be costs associated with defending those provisions.
