SHORT TITLE: Patent Infringement Amendments

2014 GENERAL SESSION

STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could cost the Courts about \$12,000 ongoing from the General Fund for every 50 cases processed beginning in FY 2015. This could also generate about \$10,000 in ongoing General Fund revenue for a net cost of \$2,000 ongoing.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

If 50 people file annually as a result of this bill they will pay \$200 on average for a total of \$10,000 in ongoing costs.
