STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will create additional workload and associated total ongoing costs of \$22,700 from the General Fund for the following agencies beginning in FY 2015. The Attorney General reports that the costs of implementing the bill are already included in its current appropriation. Individual agency estimates are:

- 1. Courts \$12,000 for judge/clerk time and jury expenses,
- 2. Attorney General \$7,800 for attorney representation, and
- 3. Guardian ad Litem \$2,900 for attorney representation.

This bill may also generate about \$6,000 in ongoing General Fund revenue.
