STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill could cost the Courts about \$37,200 in ongoing General Fund beginning in FY 2015 for additional workload. The bill's provisions could generate about \$42,500 in ongoing fee revenue to the Transportation Fund - Public Safety Restricted Account beginning in FY 2016 .

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

About 1,400 violators per year could pay a \$30 reinstatement fee for a total of about \$42,500 ongoing.
