## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Costs to the Department of Commerce to investigate potential complaints could be approximately \$8,600 annually. An estimated \$1,500 in citation revenue could be realized annually. Spending from the Commerce Service Fund affects annual transfers to the General Fund.
