This bill appropriates \$7,091,200, including \$5,080,000 from the General/Education Funds for FY 2015. To balance revenue sources, this bill decreases appropriations from the Uniform School Fund by \$18,000,000 and replaces those appropriations with Education Fund. These appropriations support the operations of public education.
