This bill appropriates \$150,000 for FY 2015, plus \$4,482,661,600, including \$858,557,900 from the General/Education funds for FY 2016. These appropriations support the operations and capital acquisitions of state government, including expendable funds and accounts. It transfers \$665,000 in FY 2016 from the General/Education funds into other funds and accounts.
