This bill appropriates -\$24,986,600, including -\$39,094,100 from the General/Education Funds for FY 2015, plus \$4,506,078,200, including \$847,269,700 from the General/Education Funds for FY 2016. These appropriations support the operations and capital acquisitions of state government, including expendable funds and accounts. It transfers another \$665,000 in FY 2016 from the General/Education funds into other funds and accounts.
