Local Government UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

The Utah State Office of Education (USOE) estimates that local education agencies (LEAs) receive approximately \$64.8 million in federal grants from sources other than the USOE. These sources may be directly from the federal government, other state agencies, other local governments or LEAs, or a state institution of higher education. Enactment of this bill may reduce the amount of federal revenue LEAs receive or have the USOE apply for, receive, and administer the federal grant program.
