purpose : The purpose of the enhanced services is to make adoption documents available to more adult adoptees.

Services : The services provided under this bill are: 1) Enhanced and more automated search of the mutual Consent, Voluntary Adoption Registry. 2) Expanded services to birth-mothers and adult adoptees. 3) Advertising of the services of the Mutual Consent, Volunta

Expected Outcome : Mothers wishing to allow access to their adoption documents will know they can register their permission formally with the Utah Department of Health. Adult adoptees will know that adoption documents are available through the Utah Department of Health. Sea

Implementations and Resources : The Utah Office of Vital Records and Statistics will implement the provisions of the Bill, some of the provisions using private sector advertising expertise and capability.

How : Advertising will be placed on the Tax Commission Website leading to greater awareness of the Mutual Consent, Voluntary Adoption Registry. Information processing and person matching will be streamlined making it possible to serve the greater population tha

## Performance Measures

### Goal

Title : Serve larger population of parents and adult adoptees interested in sharing adoption documents.

Description : Increase the Utilization of the Mutual Consent, Voluntary Adoption Registry by parents and adult adoptees, and increase success at matching and being able to provide adoption documents to adult adoptees.

Collection Method : Automated system that records use and successful matches of parents and adoptees.
