This bill appropriates (\$500,000), including (\$500,000) from the General Fund for FY 2016, plus \$912,355,300, including \$645,172,400 from the General and Education Funds for FY 2017. These appropriations support the operations and capital acquisitions of state government, including expendable funds and accounts. It transfers another \$231,000 in FY 2017 from the General Fund into other funds and accounts.
