State Government UCA 36-12-13(2)(b)

Enactment of this bill deposits \$4,132,800 in FY 2016 and \$150,000 one-time in FY 2017 into the unrestricted General Fund. It transfers another \$1,017,400 ongoing beginning in FY 2017 from the General Fund into other funds and accounts.

This bill appropriates \$53,173,800, including -\$6,666,700 from the General/Education Funds for FY 2016, plus \$4,467,352,900, including \$865,447,700 from the General/Education Funds for FY 2017. These appropriations support the operations and capital acquisitions of state government, including expendable funds and accounts. It transfers another \$1,017,400 in FY 2017 from the General/ Education funds into other funds and accounts.
