Enactment of this legislation could decrease revenue to the Transportation Fund by \$33,500 beginning in FY 2017, by eliminating a \$5 recognition special group license plate fee for "In God We Trust" license plates for 6,700 individuals.

Enactment of this legislation could cost the Tax Commission \$100,000 from the General Fund one-time in FY 2017, to produce 25,000 "In God We Trust" standard issue license plates to meet initial demand.

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Individuals that wish to have an "In God We Trust" license plate would save \$5 from the elimination of the recognition special group fee. They would still be required to pay the standard \$5 fee.
