## State Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(b)
Enactment of this legislation could decrease revenue to the Transportation Fund by $\$ 33,500$ beginning in FY 2017, by eliminating a $\$ 5$ recognition special group license plate fee for "In God We Trust" license plates for 6,700 individuals.

Enactment of this legislation could cost the Tax Commission \$100,000 from the General Fund onetime in FY 2017, to produce 25,000 "In God We Trust" standard issue license plates to meet initial demand.

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)
Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

## Individuals \& Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)
Individuals that wish to have an "In God We Trust" license plate would save $\$ 5$ from the elimination of the recognition special group fee. They would still be required to pay the standard $\$ 5$ fee.

The Legislature decides appropriations separately.
