This bill could generate revenue of about \$144,000 to the newly created General Fund Restricted - Marriage Education Account in FY 2017 and \$288,000 each year thereafter.

Local Government UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Under this bill, assuming counties increase marriage license fees by \$20 there would be no impact to local county governments. However depending on where counties price marriage license fees as a result of the bill they could retain more or less in fees however the amount is unknown.

Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Individuals who elect not to participate in pre-marital programs would pay an additional \$20 for their marriage license. An estimated 7,200 couples in FY 2017 and 14,400 each year thereafter will pay this fee for a total of \$144,000 and \$288,000 respectively. In certain counties where marriage license fees are less than \$40, couples will pay more.

Notes on Notes
