New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: The bill has two components: 1) Build strong community partnerships with schools to provide wrap-around services for students at-risk for academic failure due to behaviors of inherent in families living in conditions of poverty. Schools and community agencies are incentivized to partner through grant funding and technical assistance to improve outcomes for students and families. 2) The bill also amends code that outlines leadership development for principals leading schools in the School Turnaround Program. A component on community partnerships will be specifically added to the Leader Academy.

Services: The funding is largely spent on qualifying grants to LEAs. LEAs must render twice the amount of the grant in dollars or in-kind services. Funding is also set aside for .5 FTE to run the overall grant program at USOE and provide for an outside evaluator.

Expected Outcome: Students living in conditions of poverty will be able to excel at the same rate as their peers who are not living in conditions of poverty as measured by third and eighth grade statewide assessments of mathematics and reading. Additional measures will be used to determine if the targeted interventions provided by community partnerships are making a difference.

Implementations and Resources: Schools, in partnership with community agencies, will apply for qualifying grants. Each plan will include implementation details and expected outcomes for participants (focused on student achievement). Funding includes administration of .5 specialist at USOE to administer program and evaluation of program effectiveness.

How: Oversight and execution of program outline is a function of USOE. Without the coordination of efforts, including providing application, funding, and technical assistance, the program will not come to fruition.
