Enactment of this legislation will reduce federal funds in the Division of Child and Family Services by \$223,500.

State expenditures will be reduced by an estimated 365 cases in the Division of Child and Family Services (DCFS) if this legislation passes. The \$3,111,700 (\$2,888,200 General Fund and \$223,500 federal funds) DCFS savings results from a reduction in the need for caseworkers and services provided. Expenditures may also be affected for the Courts, the Guardian ad Litem, and the Office of the Attorney General in an indeterminable amount based upon the number of filings going up or down resulting from passage of the legislation.
