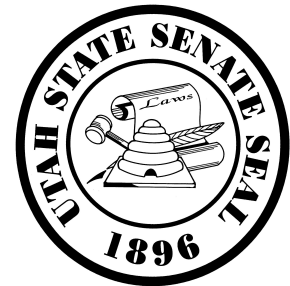

This bill deposits \$14,200,000 one-time in FY 2018 into the unrestricted General Fund.

This bill appropriates (\$359,000), including (\$1,499,000) from the Education Fund for FY 2017, plus \$2,009,678,800, including \$247,751,400 from the General/Education Funds for FY 2018. These appropriations support the operations and capital acquisitions of state government, including expendable funds and accounts.
