Enactment of this legislation could cost the Legislature \$6,000 ongoing from the General Fund (\$2,000 in the Senate and \$4,000 in the House of Representatives) beginning in FY 2018 for compensation of legislators on the council. This bill appropriates \$2,000 to the Senate and \$4,000 to the House of Representatives ongoing from the General Fund. Enactment of this legislation could also cost the Department of Agriculture and Food \$21,000 ongoing from the General Fund beginning in FY 2018 for council members" per diem and travel costs, one quarter FTE to staff the council, and report preparation costs. Costs would end mid-FY 2023 when the bill"s provisions are repealed.
