Enactment of this legislation could generate \$1,500 in revenue to the Lt. Governor - Election File Fee Fund beginning in FY 2020 and every four years thereafter from filing fees paid by vice presidential candidates who declare candidacy in Utah, or \$400 per year on an annualized basis.

Enactment of this legislation could cost the Lieutenant Governor"s Office \$1,500 every four years beginning in FY 2020 from the Lt. Governor"s Election File Fee Fund for pass-through funding to counties or \$400 per year on an annualized basis.

Enactment of this legislation could generate \$1,500 in additional revenue for counties every four years beginning in FY 2020 which would be allocated based upon a county"s share of statewide votes cast for the United States House of Representatives.

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Enactment of this legislation could cost an estimated three vice presidential candidates \$500 each for a total of \$1,500 in filling fees that would be paid every four years beginning in FY 2020.
