Enactment of this bill could cost the Department of Commerce \$40,000 one-time to cover funding for two years from the Commerce Service Fund in FY 2018 for potential investigations into violations. Spending from the Commerce Service Fund impacts year-end transfers to the General Fund. Enactment of this bill could also cost the Department of Health \$60,000 one-time from the General Fund for database development and maintenance, data analysis, and administrative oversight of the data. Funding is intended to cover two years of the program.
