This bill appropriates \$725,000 one-time and \$725,000 ongoing from the General Fund beginning in FY 2018 to the Lieutenant Governor"s Office for annualized expenses for the state and counties to administer a presidential primary election. Quadrennial state costs are estimated at \$300,000 and counties" costs are estimated at \$2,600,000 or combined for \$725,000 annually.
