Local Government UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Enactment of this bill could cost counties that do not have ballot drop boxes or do not have the minimum required number of boxes. The cost of a drop box is an estimated \$1,500. The population criteria in the bill would result in 25 counties needing the minimum of three drop boxes; four counties would need more than three to meet the requirements. The total aggregate impact for all counties would be \$136,500 one-time in FY 2018, although counties with populations less than 30,000 could apply for an exception to the minimum requirement.
