New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: The purpose of the dental clinic is to provide dental services to individuals with disabilities who do not have any form of dental coverage.

Services: The following dental treatments will be provided: Consultation Cleaning Endo anterior work Extractions Crowns (stainless steel only) General anesthesia, if required

Expected Outcome: Provide dental services to 400 individuals per year. These services will improve the health and quality of life of each individual as well as avoid millions of dollars of unnecessary medical and dental procedures caused by improper care of teeth.

Implementations and Resources: This program will incorporate most of the features developed in the Featherstone Ridge Dental Program pilot that was funded by the Legislature in General Session 2015. Initially, the program will be operated at the Utah State Developmental Center (USDC) which has the necessary space and equipment and will not interfere with USDC dental services. The program will be administered by the Superintendent of USDC who will contract for one dentist, two part-time dental techs., one part-time office manager and one nurse anesthetist.

How: The expected outcomes and public benefit will be realized by successfully performing the needed procedures and services. There are numerous studies demonstrating a direct correlation between oral care and overall health. Good oral care equals better health.
