This legislation reduces appropriations to to the Board of Regents by \$310,000 ongoing from the Education Fund starting FY 2018. This legislation also reduces appropriations to the Utah Education and Telehealth Network by \$645,000 ongoing from the Education Fund starting FY 2018. Enactment of this legislation could cost the Department of Workforce Services \$917,600 ongoing and \$7,500 one time starting FY 2018 for personnel and data processing costs. This bill appropriates \$955,000 ongoing from the General Fund starting in FY 2018 for the Department of Workforce Services.
