State Government UCA 36-12-13(2)(b)

Enactment of this bill increases revenue to the Transportation Fund by \$4,175,000 in FY 2018 and \$14,409,000 in FY 2019. From FY 2018 until the end of the tax rate increases (estimated FY 2032), the bill increases overall revenue by \$1.708 billion over what is currently expected. The bill reduces revenue to the Transportation Investment Fund by \$5,043,000 in FY 2019 and increases revenue to the General Fund by \$5,043,000 in FY 2019. Lastly, the bill increases revenue to two General Fund Restricted Accounts - the Boat Fuel Tax Restricted Account by \$20,800 in FY 2018 and \$80,800 in FY 2019 and the Off-Highway Vehicle Fuel Tax Restricted Account by \$12,800 in FY 2018 and \$49,400 in FY 2019.

Enactment of this bill increases revenue to B&C Roads programs by \$1,253,000 in FY 2018 and \$4,323,000 in FY 2019.

Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

If estimates of future wholesale fuel prices prevail, costs for gasoline and diesel fuel could increase by \$4,175,000 in FY 2018 and \$14,409,000 in FY 2019. For an individual driving 12,000 miles per year and getting 20 miles to the gallon, this could be about \$3.60 per year in FY 2018 and \$7.20 per year in FY 2019.
