Enactment of this bill initially increases revenue to the Transportation Fund by \$4,238,000 in FY 2019 and \$14,625,000 in FY 2020. From FY 2019 until the end of the tax rate increases (estimated FY 2033), the bill increases overall revenue by \$1.733 billion over what is currently expected. By changing the sales tax earmark, the bill initially reduces revenue to the Transportation Investment Fund by \$5,119,000 in FY 2020 and increases revenue to the General Fund by \$5,119,000 in FY 2020. The bill then transfers from the Transportation Fund to the Transportation Investment Fund the amount of the earmark change, amounting to \$5,119,000 in FY 2020. Lastly, the bill increases revenue to two General Fund Restricted Accounts - the Boat Fuel Tax Restricted Account by \$21,100 in FY 2019 and \$82,000 in FY 2020 and the Off-Highway Vehicle Fuel Tax Restricted Account by \$13,000 in FY 2019 and \$50,100 in FY 2020.

Enactment of this bill increases revenue to B&C Roads programs by \$1,271,000 in FY 2019 and \$4,387,000 in FY 2020.

## Individuals & Businesses

If estimates of future wholesale fuel prices prevail, costs for gasoline and diesel fuel could increase by \$4,238,000 statewide in FY 2019 and \$14,625,000 in FY 2020. For an individual driving 12,000 miles per year and getting 20 miles to the gallon, this could be about \$3.60 per year in FY 2019 and \$7.20 per year in FY 2020.
