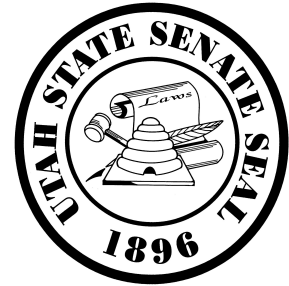

#### State Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(b)

Enactment of this legislation may result in a one-time increase to the General Fund of \$3,600 in FY 2018 and \$23,400 in FY 2019 and a one-time increase in dedicated credits of \$6,400 in FY 2018 and \$41,600 in FY 2019.

Enactment of this legislation may result in one-time increases of dedicated credits for the Department of Public Safety to process 1,300 background checks annually of \$6,400 in FY 2018 and \$41,600 in FY 2019.

#### Local Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

#### Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Approximately 1,300 individuals annually under the age of 18 will pay \$50 one-time in background check fees. Most of these individuals would have paid the \$50 upon turning 18.

#### Regulatory Impact

Enactment of this legislation likely will not change the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.

**Notes on Notes**

Fiscal notes estimate the direct costs or revenues of enacting a bill. The Legislature uses them to balance the budget. They do not measure a bill's benefits or non-fiscal impacts like opportunity costs, wait times, or inconvenience. A fiscal note is not an appropriation. The Legislature decides appropriations separately.
