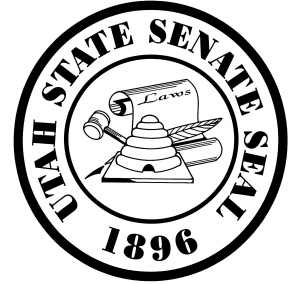

New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: Purpose: The purpose is for the Public Lands Policy Coordinating Office (PLPCO) to monitor the State Resource Management Plans (RMP) at the local and State level.

Services: PLPCO will perform State RMP updating, management and database development.

Expected Outcome: Coordinating the implementation of the State RMP at the local, state and federal level will inform policy decisions by federal land managers on the needs and planning interests of local communities.

Implementations and Resources: State RMP updating and management will require the development and maintenance of an interactive online database. The database will need to be compiled from natural resource data from all 7 Utah Associations of Government and from current State agency resource data. In addition, the database will track changes to state and county plans. A full time staff person is needed in the Public Lands Coordinating Office to monitor the implementation of the State and County RMPs. Additional duties include regular coordination and consultation with counties, state resource agencies, and federal land managers. PLPCO will also provide regular reports and updates on changes to the State RMP to the Commission for the Stewardship for Public Lands.

How: Considerable coordination will need to occur between PLPCO and 29 Utah Counties to track substantive changes to their plans throughout the year. In addition, PLPCO must work with State resource agencies to track major developments to their programs and policies. All significant changes will be analyzed by PLPCO to provide recommendations to the Commission for the Stewardship for Public Lands. A full time staff person is needed to manage the county, State agency, and federal coordination. The database is needed to compile and track all 7 AOG databases along with all of the state resource data that supports natural resource policies within the County and State RMPs.

Performance Measures

Goal

Title: Coordination with local, state, and federal government.

Description: PLPCO will work with local governments, state agencies and federal land managers to inform and update the State RMP as changes occur throughout the year.

Collection Method: Coordination with, local, state, and federal governments will be tracked and reported to the Commission for the Stewardship for Public Lands by PLPCO.
