UCA 36-12-13(2)(b)

Enactment of this bill could increase revenue to the General Fund via the Tax Commission by \$200 ongoing beginning in FY 2019 from new fees associated with direct-sale car manufacturers. Enactment of this bill could increase revenue, as pass-through, to the Department of Public Safety by \$100 ongoing beginning in FY 2019 from new background check fees associated with direct-sale care manufacturer salespersons.

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Enactment of this legislation could result in a large increase in the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.
