Enactment of this legislation creates the Director Selection Committee. Meeting costs associated with the committee are estimated to be \$1,400 annually beginning in FY 2019, funded \$800 from the General Fund for Legislative members and \$800 from the Education Fund, assuming the committee meets once per year. These costs can be absorbed. The State Board of Education could expend \$500,000 annually for personnel costs, website development and support and programmatic costs to support the ULEAD office as directed in the legislation.
