Public Benefit:

Purpose: The purpose is to promote collaboration in research and innovation between the director, research institutions, and education leaders.

Services: The following services are provided: (1) gathering and explaining current education research in an electronic research clearinghouse for use by practitioners; (2) initiating and disseminating research reports on innovative and successful practices by Utah LEAs, and guided by the steering committee, practitioners, and policymakers; (3) promote statewide innovation and collaboration; (4) report to the Legislature and policymakers on innovative and successful K-12 practices; and (5) propose policy changes to remove barriers to implementation of successful practices.

Expected Outcome: The expected outcomes are improved student achievement.

Implementations and Resources: The bill will be implemented by the director as outlined in the proposed legislation. The fiscal note is \$500,000 annually for personnel costs, website development and support and programmatic costs to support the ULEAD office as directed in the legislation.

How: The proposed agency activities will cause improved student achievement through implementation of innovative, successful educational practices.
