Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Enactment of this bill could result in a cost reduction of \$900 ongoing for the County Political Parties in FY 2019 from a reduction in the fine amount for failing to file an interim report with the Lieutenant Governor's Office in a timely manner. Additionally, individuals donors or non-profit organizations could benefit due to the requirement that political issues committees, when dissolved, return unspent funds to the original donor or donate to a tax-exempt non-profit organization.

Regulatory Impact

Enactment of this legislation likely will result in a medium reduction in the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.
