UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)
Enactment of this bill may require certain local education agencies to designate a human resource officer for the school and receive human resources training. Potential costs may vary by local education agency. The State Board of Education indicates that the Utah Department of Human Resource Management charges approximately $\$ 45 /$ hour for consulting. A training program may increase this cost for each individual that participates depending on the cost of the training program selected by the agency.
