New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: UDAF is to establish rules regarding cannabidiol. This would include setting guidelines for product registration, licensing and inspection. The UDAF would also conduct these activities once rules are in place.

Services: UDAF will ensure that cannabidiol products are properly registered, including testing and accurate labeling; that producers and processors are licensed; and complete inspections to ensure product is cultivated following established rule.

Expected Outcome: Rules will be promulgated no later than November 2018. Once rules are in place, producers and processors will be notified as to the need to be licensed and have products registered and registrations completed by June 2019. Inspections will begin once producers/processors have been licenses and inspections will occur up to four times each year.

Implementations and Resources: This is a staff heavy responsibility to write administrative rules, complete product product registration and ensuring producers/processors are licenses and facilities meet specifications.

How: Rules by 11/1/2018; production registration by 6/30/2019; inspections completed up to four times by 6/30/2020.
