Purpose: Provide up to \$100 matching contributions to 529 education savings account for qualifying intergenerational poverty household.

Services: Develop an eligibility application process and administrative process to distribute the matching contributions in a timely manner.

Expected Outcome: Provide matching contributions to qualifying 529 educational savings accounts in a timely manner.

Implementations and Resources: Developing necessary administrative processes to distribute matching contributions according to the provisions of the bill.

How: The department will ensure all provisions of the bill are incorporated into the associated administrative processes.

Title: DWS Annual Report - IGP Matching -- Education Savings Plan

Description: The DWS Annual Report for FY 2019 will include the information required by lines 100-106 of the bill, that is: (1) provide the number of parent applicants who have participated in the program; (2) provide the number of qualified children who have received a contribution from the program to the 529 savings account opened on behalf of the qualified children; (3) describe any notification or marketing efforts by the department to make the families of qualified children aware of the program; and (4) make recommendations to the Legislature regarding the effectiveness of the program and any suggestions for improving the program.

Collection Method: Items (1) and (2) will be captured in the eligibility determination system. Items (3) and (4) will be based on the department's implementation of the bill.
