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Funding For:

New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: The purpose of the grant program includes funding for existing after-school programs serving elementary and secondary students in public and charter schools to meet high quality standards described in Utah Code - Section 53E-3-508, and provide appropriate academic support to participants. Funded after-school programs will also provide student participation data to the Utah State Board of Education (USBE) in order for the USBE to conduct an evaluation of the grant program.

Services: The services include after-school programming in public and charter schools with a focus on academic support.

Expected Outcome: The expected outcome of the grant program is for funded after-school programs to meet the high quality standards described in Section 53E-3-508. The public will benefit by having increased access to after-school programs serving both elementary and secondary students which meet high quality standards of after-school programming.

Implementations and Resources: The bill will be implemented as outlined with the USBE soliciting applications, setting up the proper application review process and administering the grant program to existing after-school programs in public and charter schools. The USBE will collaborate with the Department of Workforce Services (DWS) - Office of Child Care (OCC) to align application, technical assistance and evaluation processes. The assigned USBE staff will also work closely with USBE Data and Statistics section to develop and implement appropriate evaluation strategies.

How: By administering the program accurately, collaborating with partners named in the bill and providing technical assistance to funded programs, after-school programs will meet high quality standards and by meeting high quality standards, after schools programs will provide higher quality programs to students and families.

Goal

Title: Academic impact of high-quality after-school programs.

Description: Funded programs will submit participation data and the USBE will measure growth and proficiency utilizing available and age appropriate assessments. Once the appropriate assessments are identified, targets will be set for FY 2020 with FY 2019 serving as the baseline year.

Collection Method: This information will be collected by the USBE staff and partner(s) from funded programs The USBE Data and Statistic will conduct the evaluation.
