New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: The purpose of this bill is to meter secondary water in the State.

Services: As stated in lines 36 - 42 of the bill, a secondary water provider that begins providing new service on or after May 9, 37 2018, shall meter the use of water by an end consumer. A secondary water supplier that primarily supplies pressurized secondary water to: a) commercial, industrial, or institutional users shall meter the use of water by July 1, 40 2023; b) residential users shall meter the use of water by July 1, 2026; and c) agricultural users shall meter the use of water by July 1, 2028.

Expected Outcome: Improved data on secondary water use.

Implementations and Resources: Secondary water providers are required to meter water and provide water use data to the state engineer and the Division of Water Resources.

How: The Divisions of Water Rights and Water Resources will track progress reported by secondary water providers.

Title: Annual Report of Progress.

Description: As systems report on an annual basis, the number of connections retrofitted will be able to be tracked and compared to the targets set in lines 36 to 42.

Collection Method: Annual report to the Division of Water Rights and Water Resources.
