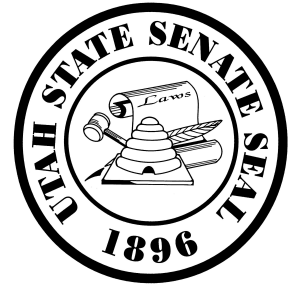

Purpose:

Services: The services provided by this funding would include an investigator and a prosecutor to review any case in which a victim is not satisfied by the progress made by law enforcement or district/county attorneys in the original jurisdiction. Since this law would apply to any law enforcement agency or government attorneys office in the state, the impact is anticipated to be significant.

Expected Outcome: The expected outcome would be substantial review of any cases submitted to the AGO for review, potential sanctions of any entity found to be mishandling cases, potential prosecution by the AGO, etc.

Implementations and Resources: The Attorney General's Office estimates it would need to add two staff to the office to carry out the mandates outlined in this bill: a full-time investigator and a full-time prosecutor.

How: The proposed activities may require review of hundreds of cases per year.

Title: The goal of this program is to evaluate existing cases to determine if they have languished in the hands of law enforcement agencies or attorneys in local jurisdictions.

Description: Case File Review requested
