Enactment of this bill could generate an estimated \$2,000 in ongoing General Fund revenue for the Lt. Governor's Office beginning in FY 2020 from fines for Political Issues Committees not reporting contributions in a timely manner. The bill could also generate \$100 in General Fund revenue for each new late fee issued to a Political Action Committees due to an increase in required convention reports.
