Enactment of this bill could increase dedicated credit revenue by \$23,400 in FY 2020 and \$11,700 ongoing beginning in FY 2021 to the Department of Public Safety. Where applicable, this bill could have the following impacts to the following accounts by an unknown amount: (1) decrease to the Public Safety Restricted Account - \$32/applicant/instance for driver license renewal; (2) increase to DPS dedicated credits - \$25/applicant for an eligibility certificate; and (3) decrease to DOC dedicated credits - \$100/sex offender registrant/year.

Enactment of this bill could have the following costs: (1) Public Safety - \$9,200 in FY 2020 and \$4,600 in FY 2021 in dedicated credits; and (2) Corrections - \$14,200 in FY 2020 and \$7,100 in FY 2021 for processing, research, and legal services. In addition, this could cost the Department of Public Safety \$2,400 one-time from the Public Safety Restricted Account in FY 2019 for programming changes.

Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

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Individuals & Businesses

About 102 individuals in FY 2020 and 51 in FY 2021 could pay about \$230 in application fees each for a total of \$23,400 in FY 2020 and \$11,700 in FY 2021. Where applicable, certain individuals could have the following fee impacts although total impact is unknown: (1) savings - \$32/year for driver license renewal; (2) cost - \$25/applicant for an eligibility certificate; and (3) savings - \$100/sex offender registrant/year.

Enactment of this legislation could result in a small reduction in the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.
