Enactment of this legislation may increase ongoing federal revenues for the Department of Health by \$82,500 beginning in FY 2020.

Enactment of this legislation may cost the Department of Health ongoing beginning in FY 2020 \$82,500 General Fund and \$82,500 federal funds for administering a new Medicaid waiver program. Additionally, the State may pay up to \$20,000 per in vitro fertilization. Higher education institutions would likely see a similar impact to health insurance costs. Finally, new reporting requirements may cost PEHP \$5,000 annually. PEHP has indicated that it can absorb these costs.
