Funding For:

New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: Facilitate access to Hepatitis C treatment for uninsured individuals.

Services: The funding increase will provide capacity at the Utah Department of Health to develop and implement a Hepatitis C Outreach Pilot Program. Services provided through the Program include: develop, issue and monitor grants for the provision of Hepatitis C treatment for uninsured individuals.

Expected Outcome: Uninsured individuals will have access to Hepatitis C treatment.

Implementations and Resources: .70 FTEs are needed to develop, implement, coordinate and monitor the activities described in the bill; FTEs will be housed within and supported by the Utah Department of Health Bureau of Epidemiology.

How: Activities described in the bill will facilitate the availability of funding for community based non-profit organizations to assist 6-7 uninsured individuals, per year, in accessing treatment for Hepatitis C.

Goal

Title: Hepatitis C Outreach

Description: Increased access to treatment for Hepatitis C among uninsured individuals.

Collection Method: Recipients of grant funds will collect and report required data to the Utah Department of Health. The Utah Department of Health will analyze data and distribute evaluation and performance outcome reports as required by the bill and/or as requested.
