Local Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Enactment of this legislation could cost individuals or businesses \$100 per product for registration and \$60 in processing fees, with estimated cumulative impact on the industry of \$160,000 per year, starting in FY 2020. In addition, those violating the statute could be subject to administrative fines up to \$500 for first violation and up to \$1,000 for subsequent violations. The total estimated fines per year is \$12,000.

Regulatory Impact

UCA 36-12-13(2)(e)

Enactment of this legislation could result in a medium increase in the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.

Notes on Notes

Fiscal notes estimate the direct costs or revenues of enacting a bill. The Legislature uses them to balance the budget. They do not measure a bill's benefits or non-fiscal impacts like opportunity costs, wait times, or inconvenience. A fiscal note is not an appropriation. The Legislature decides appropriations separately.
