Purpose: This program will promote energy innovation and clean air solutions.

Services: Services include a grant program for residential and commercial/industrial projects that demonstrate clean and advanced energy solutions.

Expected Outcome: Outcomes include new investment, jobs, and emissions reductions from energy related sources.

Implementations and Resources: The bill will be implemented by the Office of Energy Development and will be structured in a manner similar to other existing OED programs.

How: Applications for grants will be submitted via a web-based portal. Applications will be evaluated by OED technical personnel and awards will be merit-based. Contracts will be established with grantees that include milestones and reporting on metrics.
