Performance Note Report

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Agency: State Board of Education

Funding For:

New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: This bill creates a Teacher and Student Success Program to improve school performance and student academic achievement. Annually the Legislature shall appropriate money from the Teacher and Student Success Account to the Board for the Teacher and Student Success Program. LEAs should utilize funds to carry out the objectives of their teacher and student success plan which conforms to their LEA Board adopted framework.

Services: LEAs should utilize funds to increase the base salary/benefits for school personnel and to carry out the objectives of their teacher and student success plan. The plan should include objectives that improve school performance and student academic achievement such as school personnel stipends, professional learning, FTEs, technology, programs outside of the regular school day, class size reduction strategies, augment existing programs, or other means. Funds cannot be utilized for capital expenditures, district level administration costs, to supplant funding for existing public education programs, or for purposes outside of the approved plan.

Expected Outcome: Individual schools should demonstrate at least a 1% increase in the school's total points received under the statewide school accountability system compared to the previous school year or qualify for and satisfy the performance standards that will be determined by the State Board of Education.

Implementations and Resources: Each LEA's framework must be submitted to the State Board of Education. Each school principal or charter school director must submit a plan to their LEA governing board to approve or disapprove and ensure that the plan conforms to the LEA's board adopted student success framework.

How: Local School Boards are charged with monitoring compliance with school plans and specified outcomes. The USBE has no role in monitoring or reporting performance measures by design of the legislation.

Performance Measures

Goal

Title: Performance measures will be set by each individual school's plan. Legislation specifically excludes the USBE from establishing or monitoring each plan.

Description: See individual school plans.

Collection Method: Local boards are charged with setting goals and performance metrics and monitoring outcomes.
