New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: To assist in addressing the health professional shortages that may cause disparities in access to health care by providing incentives to qualified health care providers to work in rural and underserved communities.

Services: To provide student loan repayment to eligible health care providers in exchange for working for at least two years in an approved, rural or under-served area.

Expected Outcome: To award approximately 15 health care providers with loan repayment assistance and decrease health professional shortages in Utah.

Implementations and Resources: The bill will be implemented by the Utah Department of Health, Office of Primary Care and Rural Health. A total of 0.27 FTE will be dedicated to the program by approximately seven employees.

How: The proposed activities will cause an increase in the number of qualified primary care (medical, dental, and mental health) providers in designated shortage areas.
